# **Post-Secondary Education**

- <u>Technical Institute</u>: e.g. BCIT. Programs like electronics, robotics, trades training...
- <u>Apprenticeship</u>: on the job trades training. See Mrs. Cossentine if you want to start an apprenticeship while in high school.



- Plan to take Grade 11 electives <u>BEFORE</u> Grade 12 electives.
- Recommended prerequisites exist for academic subjects. E.g. Chem 11 <u>BEFORE</u> Chem 12






