Planning 10	4 Credits	Dual credit continues to expand and grow with nearly 70% of our Grade 12's taking a dual credit course in the 2016/2017 school year. A college instructor will travel to EMCS throughout the semester to teach their course in a related high school block. At the end of the course, successful students not only get credit for the grade 12 course, they get college credits as well. The district pays for the textbook and the course fee from Camosun. The only charge to the students is the approximate \$40.20 one-time Camosun application fee.
