## Kids Plus<sup>™</sup> Accident Insurance policy changes

Effective this September 1<sup>st</sup>, there will be some changes to our Kids Plus<sup>™</sup> Accident Insurance policy that will impact our Active Plan holders. Permanent Total Disability coverage will be reduced from \$360,000 to \$100,000 and Dismemberment or Total & Permanent Loss of Use from \$200,000 to \$100,000.
