All grads need to return their v-stole to the office as soon as possible. You will be charged \$38.00 if you do not return the stole, and you will be unable to purchase tickets for prom.


Prom tickets are available for sale in the office. Please have them purchased by Monday, June 11th so we have final numbers to give to the Empress.
