SIR PERCY LAKE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Military and/or Legion association is not required; the scholarship is open to all students.

The amount of the Scholarship is \$2,000.00 and is sponsored by all Legion Branches in the South Vancouver Island Zone.

To be eligible, a Senior Secondary Student must be accepted in their first year to the University of Victoria, or Royal Roads Campus or Vancouver Island University: Nanaimo and Cowichan Campus starting in the year the scholarship is presented. The scholarship can only be held over to the 2nd semester, at which time if not used, the scholarship will be forfeited. The student must be a resident of the area encompassed by South Vancouver Island Zone of The Royal Canadian Legion.

The South Vancouver Island Zone Branches are located in Greater Victoria, the Saanich Peninsula, Western Communities, Sooke, mid Vancouver Island and the southern Gulf Islands.
