Important - Updated Bell Schedule

Teachers will be ready to greet students 10 minutes before the beginning of class, but we will not be allowing students to enter the building early. Please plan accordingly to come to school just before the start of your class.

Workbook/Class Fees

Fees will be posted on https://sd62.schoolcashonline.com/ at the start of each class, and books ordered will be delivered to teachers to hand out in class at the start of each day. Please note when "attaching" your student in School Cash Online you will need their PEN not their pupil/student number (even though School Cash Online calls it a "student" number). <u>Masks</u>

All students have now been offered a complimentary mask from their teacher. We recommend that students own masks that are comfortable and fit well. It will be important that students remember to bring a clean mask each day as they are required in public areas such as hallways, washrooms, busses, and anytime they are outside of their classroom and distancing cannot be maintained. The school does not have a supply of spare masks for times when one is forgotten. We may need to call home and ask that a parent/guardian bring a mask to the school if a student forgets theirs at home.

School Visitors

We encourage parents and guardians to continue to reach out to the school via phone (250-642-5211) and email (emcs@sd62.bc.ca). Anyone who is not a student or staff member must be pre-approved and prearrange entry to the school site by a Vice Principal or the Principal. Visitors must also complete health and safety orientation. This is restricted to services essential to the educational and physical well-being

of the school. In the majority of situations, it is much easier and more efficient to connect via phone, email or MS Teams.
