

Grade 10 Assessments

In order to graduate, students are now required to write two provincial assessments in grade 10: a Literacy Assessment and a Numeracy Assessment. The Literacy Assessment 12 is postponed this year.

So, *ALL* grade 10 students will write a Literacy and Numeracy Assessment this year. They will do so in four windows: November 2-6, January 25 - 29, April 12 -16, and June 14-23. Students will write these assessments with their Science 10 (Numeracy) and Social Studies 11 (Literacy) classes. Grade 11 students that did not write their Numeracy and Literacy Assessment in Spring 2020 will also be scheduled to write their Assessments this year. Click here for the schedule.
