There are many ways to extend your core program at EMCS!

Students in all grades can enroll in the EMCS **Leadership Program**. This is a tremendous opportunity for students who want to learn as part of a fun, vibrant community! Students have opportunities to develop their personal leadership skills while contributing to the life of the school and community. Grade 12 students can also work on

the Grad Council through Leadership.

Students can also extend their high school education by coupling it with higher-level and post-secondary learning and credits. These include our AP and Dual Credit courses. These options can be found in their respective academic departments: AP Art, AP English, Dual Credit Biology, Dual Credit Calculus, Dual Credit Law, and Dual Credit Psychology.

If you are a senior student engaged in paid work, contact your Careers Teacher about opportunities to gain credit for **work experience**, and participate in **Apprenticeships**. Many of the apprenticeship opportunities lead into trades programs at the post-secondary level.

The EMCS Inclusive Education Service is available for students who require additional support and practice to enhance their learning and success in school. As well as supporting student learning needs the IES department at EMCS also works to identify learning barriers, advocate for support and develop plans to facilitate student success.

The Inclusive Education Services also offers a Peer tutoring course. This course provides the opportunity for students to explore and develop their skills and talents, while gaining an understanding of people and how they learn.


