The **Athletics Awards Ceremony** is Wednesday, May 24th at 7:00 pm. All students who participated on a school team and their families are welcome to come join us in celebrating another successful year of sports at EMCS. Tickets are \$5.00 each and go on sale Monday May 15th in the office. We look forward to seeing you May 24th

Yearbooks are available to purchase, they can be paid for with cash or with a cheque made out to "School District 62". Please see a yearbook member in the commons at lunch to purchase or drop by the office outside of class hours.

Grad Tickets

Grad tickets went on sale May 8th. **Please see attachment for detailed instructions.** The UVic Ticket Center has a list of all of our grads who are currently on the grad list. They will only complete sales to families of students on the list. Please remember that the 3 tickets that are included with the grad fees must also be booked through the ticket center.

For families requiring more than 6 tickets, in mid to late May an announcement will be made that tickets are no longer reserved and you will be able to purchase as many additional tickets as you need, based on availability. Because of the need to maintain the reservation of tickets for our families until that time, and because tickets are assigned seating, it is most likely that the tickets you purchase after the reservations will be for seats not adjacent to those you originally purchased.

Grad List

The EMCS Grad List is being updated daily, only students on the Grad List will be able to:

- participate in the Grad Ceremony
- book 3 free tickets for the ceremony (sales begin May 8)
- purchase additional tickets for the ceremony (May 8)
- purchase prom tickets (ticket sales date TBA)

Grad List requirements include:

- on track to graduate in June with enough credits
- passing all required courses
- completing any required distance learning courses
- turning in all Grad Transitions packages
- turning in a Grad Comment to the office
- returning any overdue library books and/or missing textbooks
- paying the Grad Fee and any other fees at the office

The Grad List will be updated daily with a final deadline of May 26. Students not on the Grad List by May 26 will not participate in the graduation ceremony.

Please note that grad ceremony tickets are assigned seating, so getting on the list quickly means you'll be able to book the best seats for friends and family.

During homeroom on Monday, May 1st, students who were <u>NOT</u> on the Grad List received a form in their homeroom class that indicated what steps must be taken to get on the list. Please remind your child not to lose that form. Students not on the list will need to get their form signed by various staff members as they meet Grad List requirements and then turn the completed form in to their counsellor. The counsellor will then add the student's name to the Grad List.

Copies of the Grad List forms were also mailed home.

Bus Registration

We are pleased to announce that online bus registration for the 2017/18 school year has opened and will remain open until Friday, June 2, 2017. Similar to last year's registration process, we will only be accepting online registrations through the School Cash Online account process – if you haven't already done so, you will be required to set up an account in order to register for bussing services for the 2017/18 school year. Bus registration will be open until June 2nd at which time routes will be established and communicated to registered riders. Riders registering after this date will be assigned routes only if space is available.

Students will not be provided bussing unless they have registered for this service.

At their April 25th meeting, the Board of Education confirmed the following:

• There will be no transportation fees charged for the 2017/18 school year

The District will provide a total of 29 routes, which is up one from the 2016/17 school year

• The 29 routes will provide service to approximately 3,300 riders or roughly one third of our student population based on the 2016/17 service levels.
