<u>Student Schedules</u> - Student schedules will be available for pick up at the EMCS office between Tuesday, August 29 and Friday, September 1 between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Students are encouraged to pick up their timetables during this time and ensure there are no errors. <u>Timetables are subject to change depending on class size and other factors; therefore all students will receive a current timetable in their first homeroom class.</u>

<u>Counselling</u> In preparation for the 2017-2018 school year, we will be working on student schedules during the summer. We will adjust student schedules based on 2016-2017 final marks, provincial exam results, and summer school marks. The school's timetable is being built based on the carefully selected course requests students and parents submitted earlier this school year. Requests for course changes will be considered only under certain circumstances. For example, requesting changes to be in classes with friends is not something we can accommodate. 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<u>Locks and Lockers</u> – Returning students are assigned the same locker and combination they had last year. Students are not allowed to bring locks from home. If you choose not to have your assigned locker, <u>you must let the office staff know</u>.
