Important Information for All Students

This year, we will be transitioning from Career Cruising to My Blue Print. My Blue Print is a web-based platform that provides students with two key tools:

- It allows students to build a reflection portfolio regarding their learning and planning about
 <u>Career-Life Education</u>, <u>Career-Life Connections</u>, Grad Transitions, and <u>Core Competencies</u>. In
 addition to ongoing learning, these portfolios will help students build their Grade 12 Capstone
 Project.
- My Blue Print will also be the primary tool students use to learn about, and plan their course
 and career pathways, and to explore post-secondary education. Students will also be using this
 tool this spring when they work with their counsellors to select their courses for next school
 year.
