Dear EMCS Families:

We are looking forward to welcoming you back for the 2021/22 school year. As Principal, I am excited to be returning to my community and joining the students and staff at EMCS.

The school year begins on Tuesday September 7th for grade 9s (8:40am-12:00pm) and for all grades (9-12) on Wednesday September 8th (all students will attend for the full day). The information included in this package will assist you and your family in preparing for the 2021/22 school year. Remember to check our school website, school app, and the EMCS Newsletter, regularly for more information and updates.

Please note that all staff and students will be required to wear masks when we return to school. Any other information regarding health protocols will be released at a later date once guidelines have been updated by the School District and Ministries.

Opening Week

Tuesday, September 7th – Opening Day (Grade 9s only, half day)

8:40am Students with last names A–K: will be greeted at the back entrance (playing field side) by Vice Principal Mr. Powell and Counsellor Ms. Jesson and students with last names L–Z: will be greeted at the front entrance by Vice Principal Mr. Mennie and Counsellor Mr. Phipps. Students will receive a schedule as they arrive on the morning of the 7th, but they are also available through the My Ed Student and Parent Portal.

Student Course Schedules

Grade 9s - Will receive their schedules when they arrive at school on Tuesday, September 7th.

<u>Grade 10-12s</u> – Draft schedules will be available in the Student and Family MyEducation BC portal on Tuesday, August 24th. Instructions on how to access the portal and view your schedule can be found <u>here</u>. If you have difficulty accessing your account, you can view instructions on resetting your password <u>here</u> (make sure to use the 'forgot my password' link and keep in mind that you need to remember the email address you usually use to sign into the portal).

Schedules are subject to change depending on class size and other factors.

Beginning August 31, counsellors will adjust student schedules based on 2020-2021 final marks, summer school marks, and completion of online courses. Students should check their schedules carefully and submit an online course change form if changes are required due to unsuccessful courses from last school year, summer school or online course completion. All requests for course changes are made by submitting an online course change form

Counsellors have done their best to create schedules that will lead to success, but we rely on you to identify errors. Please look for unbalanced schedules (such as all academics in one semester), missing graduation or post-secondary requirements, gaps, or "See Counsellor" notes. Usually, these indicate that we have done our best to fulfill your requests but need more information.

All other questions will be addressed after school starts. A reminder that we do not accommodate student requests for certain teachers or to be in a class with their friends. New registrations who are in catchment will be contacted by their VP, Counsellor or a clerical staff member regarding course selection or incomplete registration information. Course change forms will not be accepted after **September 10, 2021**

Bussing

Lockers

Lockers are not automatically assigned, those students who would like a locker need to speak to clerical staff to request one. Lockers are the most secure place for storing personal belongings and we encourage students to use them. We urge students not to share lockers or to give anyone else their lock combination. Students are not allowed to bring locks from home or to switch lockers. At the end of the year, any student who has lost or damaged their lock will be charged a \$5.00 fee.
