

SOOKE HARBOURSIDE LIONS' BURSARY GUIDELINES



There are two (2) Sooke Harbourside Lions Club bursaries awarded:

1. The Pat Moreau Memorial Bursary - Awarded at \$1000.00

Pat Moreau was the charter secretary for what we used to be called – The Sooke Lioness. She served in many other capacities from Director to President and lived in Sooke most of her life. She and her husband, Leo raised a son and two daughters in Sooke. Volunteering was her passion and she did a lot to serve this community in her short life of 47 years. This bursary is awarded in her memory.

2. The Lion Audrey Wilson Bursary - Awarded at \$1000.00

Lion Audrey Wilson, wife of Past District Governor John Wilson, passed away December 16, 2013. Thoughtful, fun, active, caring, often 'mother hen' to her fellow Sooke Harbourside Lions, Audrey was an outstanding community servant and a great friend to so many of us. Audrey served as a Lioness and a Lion in Sooke for nearly 30 years. She and John lived in Sooke their entire lives, where Audrey had served as a kindergarten teacher to many in the community. This bursary is awarded in her memory.

Criteria

- 1. These bursaries are meant to be applied to post-secondary program at a recognized university, college, vocational school or technical school.
- 2. Applicants must demonstrate community service. Applicants must show they have been involved in volunteering in school and/or community.
- 3. Applicants must be in Grade 12 at Edward Milne Community School.

Application Deadline

Applications are due to the EMCS Counselling Department by 8:45am on the first Monday of May.

Bursary Presentation and Payment

The successful applicant will be awarded the bursary at the EMCS Graduation Ceremony. The bursary will be paid directly to the successful applicant by the Sooke Harbourside Lions Club on receipt of proof of enrollment, e.g. student ID number, tuition receipt.

Successful applicants have two (2) years to use the bursary. If after two (2) years, the applicant has not entered a post-secondary school program, the money is forfeited unless there are extenuating circumstances.
