



As result of the commitment to Valentines for Veterans, SD 62 staff and students provided over 900 Valentines for this project!


These were distributed to local Veterans, Active Military personnel and deployed Troops by Langford Legion volunteers; many being delivered locally today.

- Capstone Project approval deadline


