School Bus Transportation

Please note: To register for school bussing, you will need your child's 6 – 7-digit Pupil #.

Many of the buses and routes fill quickly. Please register close to opening so that you get a spot!

Bus Routes Notification

Bus routes for the 2023-24 school year have been created. Students will be placed on routes as per the address provided during registration. Registrations received by June 30, will receive route schedules via email by mid-summer.

Routes will be posted just prior to route schedules being sent out.

Bus Passes

Bus Passes will be handed out during the first week of school in September.

All fully registered middle and secondary students will receive a pass and must carry it as proof of ridership. Drivers will check for passes. **Students without passes may be refused.**

Permanent bus passes that are misplaced will cost \$10 to replace. Please contact the Transportation Department to replace a bus pass.

- Parents can only use the system if they have an email address on record at the school. This means that you need to ensure that the office has your correct email address.
- You will be sent an email with a confirmation code. Enter the code and complete the consent choices listed below:
- If there are numerous siblings in the family, once you have logged on, you will see all of them.
- New accounts take 24 hours/overnight to be created.

Expiry of Consents

- Some consents (namely GAFE) expire once a student leaves the district and/or graduates.
- Some consents last one school year.
- The system tracks the expiry of these consents. To renew a consent year to year (for Internet access, as an example) a parent simply reconnects to the system next school year. The system will note that the consent has expired and will give parents an opportunity to renew their permission.

Special Consideration – GAFE Consents

- Parents provide consent for their child(ren) to have a SD62 learns Google Accounts by going online to the same website as above: <https://consent.sd62.bc.ca>
- GAFE has a two-tiered consent system in our district. Both parents and students must provide their consents.
- In order for a student to follow these steps, **the parent must have first** given their consent at the URL given above.
 - If a student tries to give consent BEFORE the parent, the system will tell them they can't proceed until the parent consent has been collected.
- Once parental consent has been received, a student can visit the library learning commons to have their Google Account created or they can complete the following steps from home:
 - Students visit the special consent portal at <https://gafe.sd62.bc.ca>
 - Students login with their SD62 username = Pupil number/Student number and password = 123456
 - Write down the new Google account login. (e.g., ab1234@sd62learns.org)
 - The Google Account format is Initial of first name, Initial of last name, last four numbers of the pupil number)
 - The system will tell them what their new username will be (it takes a day to come into effect)

SCHOOL COMPUTERS AND INTERNET ACCESS

EMCS Password Processes



To use any of the online apps and programs designed for EMCS students, consent by a parent or guardian must have first been completed.

Go to: <https://consent.sd62.bc.ca/>

Log in using the parent email on file at school. You will be sent an email with a confirmation code. Enter the code and complete the consent choices for both District Wide Consents and School Level (EMCS) Consent for My Blueprint (found below District wide consents)

(Parent/guardian needs to do student online consent choices first. To use this link, you need your Pupil Number, Home Phone Number and Parent Email registered on MyEdBC at the school.)

Open your web browser. Type "emcs.appazur.com". Then tap the "App Store" or "Google Play" button.

Open the "App Store" app on your iPhone/iPad. Search for "EMCS Wolverines". Tap "Get". It's free!

Windows, Mac, & ChromeOS:

Type "emcs.appazur.com" into your browser (Chrome or Safari recommended).

GET STARTED!!

- Tap the menu button (at the top left).
- In the menu, tap "Sign In". Use your school account if you have one. Otherwise: If you have not signed in before, "Sign Up" for a new account.
- Tap "Classes" in the menu, then tap the gear to select your classes.
- Tap "Groups" in the menu, then tap the gear to select your clubs, teams, and other groups that you belong to.
- Tap the menu choice with the gear icon and your name, and pick how you want to receive notifications.

MY BLUEPRINT



[myBlueprint](#) is a web-based platform that provides students with two key tools:

1. It allows students to build a reflection portfolio regarding their learning and planning about [Career-Life Education](#), [Career-Life Connections](#), and [Core Competencies](#). In addition to ongoing learning, these portfolios will help students build their Grade 12 Capstone Project.
 2. myBlueprint will also be the primary tool students use to learn about, and plan career pathways, and to explore post-secondary education, and to select secondary courses for grades 10-12.
- Under the Students tab on the EMCS website, you'll find the link to the myBlueprint log on page.
 - Select "School Account Login"

Login Tips:

The Temporary Password: DO NOT copy/paste the password – the copy process sometimes adds a space. It MUST be entered exactly. It is case sensitive.

Criteria to reset a new Password must be followed:

- 8 minimum, 14 maximum characters
- 1 capital letter, 1 lowercase letter
- 1 number
- 1 special symbol or character: # or \$ or ! or @

- Your password cannot contain, first name, middle name, last name, date of birth, personal id or sequential letters or numbers
- Samples of acceptable password: Jan2017\$/Snow999!/Welcome1\$

Write your password down and keep it in a secure area for future reference!

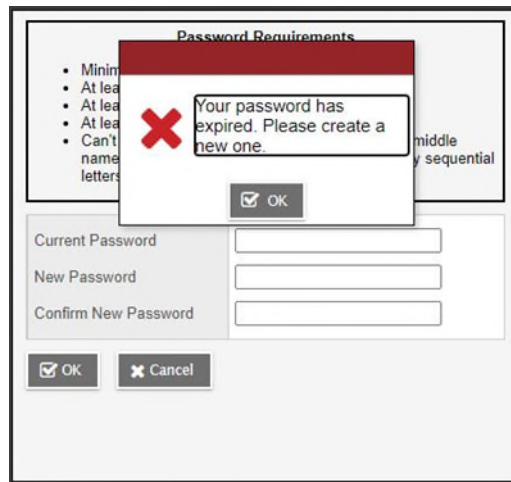
If You Forget Your Password:

1. Enter your Login ID
 - Students – this is your student number.
 - Parents - this is the email you provided to MyEd.
2. Click on “I forgot my password”
3. MyEd will email you a new temporary password.

Passwords are good for 90 days, at which time after a successful login you will be required to create a new password immediately.

Ten unsuccessful login attempts will disable your account and if this happens you will have to wait for it to be re-enabled. You will have to call the school office to request that your account be re-activated. This may take a few days or longer.

How to Make a Purchase:

Step 1. – Consent for your student's information to be shared with school cash online at <https://consent.sd62.bc.ca/apps/OnlineConsent>; please allow 24 hours for the system to update before proceeding to Step 2.

If you've already done this, please skip to Step 2.

Step 2. – Register for School Cash Online Account at sd62.schoolcashionline.com and "attach" your student in School Cash Online to see their specific fees. You will need your student's PEN number which can be found through your My Ed Parent Portal Login at <https://myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspen/logon.do>.
