



## **Grade 12 Updates!**

Make sure to check the <u>Grade 12 Timeline</u> for a list of important dates and things to do during your Grade 12 year!

#### **November Timeline**

- Check for the updated list of **post-secondary info sessions** taking place.
- November 14, 2023: Capstone Activity Log AND Mentor Notes #1 are due.
- Nov 20: Purdy's fundraising closes.
- First draft of your scholarship/bursary letter of application should be done.
- Transcript Verification Report: This report will be mailed home in late November or early
- December. The report contains your demographic information as well as completed courses, credits, and courses in progress. Ensure all information is accurate. See your School Counsellor if there are any errors on the report. The name on the TVR will be as it appears on your high school diploma which will be mailed to the address listed in the summer following graduation.

Make sure you are on track to graduate at the end of your Grade 12 year! Double check your timetable to make sure you are scheduled for the courses you need to graduate. If you aren't sure, make an appointment to see your Counsellor.
