As well, our counselling and clerical staff will be visiting your classes at Journey to support you with the course selection process.

Course Selection Timeline:

- **February 5th-23rd** - Course selection open to families in MyEducationBC Student Portal
- **February 8th** - Grade 8 Parent info night (students and parents @6pm EMCS theatre to learn about elective choices, Careers and Academy information and tour of school) **Please bring the Course Planning Sheet**
- **February 12th** - Submit your completed Course Planning Sheet to your Grade 8 teacher for review
- **February 20th-23rd** – EMCS clerical and Admin visit Journey grade 8 classes to address questions or difficulty with the process

Included with this welcome letter is additional information to help you prepare for Grade 9. In the MyEducationBC Student Portal Handbook, you will find information on:

- how to log on to the Student Portal (which is the very important first step)
- how to view your report card
- how to view your course schedule
- how to select your courses. It is key to familiarize yourself right away with this process because **course selection is due February 20th**

Prior to EMCS admin and clerical staff visiting Journey classes on **February 20th -23rd**, visit the EMCS website and view the Course Selection page (under the "Counselling" tab). Use the included **Course Planning Worksheet** to select the courses. Please work through this planning sheet with your parents or caregivers and hand in to your Grade 8 teacher for review by **February 12th**.

We look forward to supporting the high school portion of your educational pathway for the next four years. You will be joining an environment where we strive to ensure all students feel valued and have a sense of belonging to their school community. Our goal at EMCS is to support all learners to pursue excellence in their social, emotional, physical and intellectual development.
