Please include any hobbies, special interests, activities or other information you would like the committee to know about you.
One letter of reference from a <b>community member</b> in support of your current community involvement. ( <i>not school related</i> )
A resume.
One letter of reference from an employee currently working with SD62.
A current transcript.
