





March Timeline

- March 15, 2024: 30 hours of work experience / volunteer time / passion project must be complete.
- March 15, 2024: Capstone Project approval deadline. (last day of preview sessions)
- Check the <u>Scholarship & Bursary section of the EMCS website</u>. MANY updates are usually made in March.

Make sure you are on track to graduate at the end of your Grade 12 year! Double check your timetable to make sure you are scheduled for the courses you need to graduate. If you aren't sure, make an appointment to see your Counsellor.
