#### **Grad Information**

**Grad Rehearsal: Friday, June 7 @ UVic**—The grad rehearsal is mandatory for all grads who are taking part in the Grad Ceremony on Saturday. We will be travelling by school bus, and students cannot drive themselves (as this is a school event). Buses will be leaving EMCS at 8:50am, so don't be late! They will be arriving back at EMCS before the end of day bell. Do not wear/bring your cap and gown, but it is strongly recommend that you bring the shoes that you will be wearing during the actual ceremony in order to practice walking across the stage (and the 3 different floorings)

Grad Ceremony: Saturday, June 8 @ UVic Jamie Cassells Centre (Farquhar Auditorium) – 1:00pm sharp—The group photo is at 12:30pm, on the grassy area at the back of the auditorium/stage entrance. If you aren't there at 12:30, you won't be in the photo.As traffic on McKenzie and parking can be an issue, give yourself plenty of time to arrive, and **aim to be at UVic by 12:15pm (or earlier)**. The gardens at UVic are amazing, and offer some great cap and gown photo backdrops.

The best places to park are Lots 2 & 4 (see the map <u>here</u>). We will not have a photographer inside taking pictures of grads as they cross the stage, so please feel free to take pictures of your own grad. Only take pictures of your own grad, be aware of privacy guidelines, and do not post to social media.

The ceremony will be livestreamed. If you wish to hold on to the V stole afterwards for pictures, please notify Mr. Powell.

## Make sure to check the <u>Grade 12 Timeline</u> for a list of important dates and things to do during your Grade 12 year!

#### June Timeline

- <u>Student Aid BC</u> application opens for applying for provincial & federal student loans and grants. Before you can apply for student loans/grants you need to get signed up for a <u>BC Services Card</u>.
- Be sure you are passing all your courses. If you are fail a course that is required for graduation, you will not earn your high school diploma.
- Look over the <u>BC Graduation Requirements</u> and make sure your are on track to graduate. See your School Counsellor if you have questions. Students are responsible for understanding BC graduation requirements and ensuring they have sufficient credits and required courses to earn a high school diploma. Participation in cap and gown ceremonies does **NOT** mean you have met graduation requirements.
- June 7, 2024: Mandatory Grad rehearsal
- June 8, 2024: Grad Ceremonies at UVIC.– After Grad, return your stole to Mr. Powell. If not returned, you will be charged a \$40.00 replacement fee.
- June 12, 2024: Grad Walk at Elementary Schools and Journey Middle School
- June 22, 2024: Prom at the Empress Hotel
- <u>Prom Events</u> The event will run from 7:00 11:00pm– Parents must check-in with a Vice Principal before leaving– Students must be in good standing with the school and follow our Code of Conduct for the duration of the event. <u>Prom Policies & Behaviour Expectations</u>
