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Upcoming Graduation Assessments

Literacy and Numeracy Assessments are provincial assessments and a graduation requirement. To graduate, a student must write the following assessments:

- Numeracy 10 (NME-10)
- Literacy 10 (LTE-10)
- Literacy 12 (LTE-12)
- And, if in French Immersion, Literacy 12- French (LTF-12)

Literacy and Numeracy Assessments are not tied to Math and English specifically, rather, they evaluate mastery of a student's literacy and numeracy skills over the course of their education.

For the October 28-30, 2024 sitting, the following students will be writing these assessments:

- Grade 12 Students will be writing the Literacy 12 Assessment
- Any Grade 12 students missing NME-10 and/or LTE-10 (have been identified by their counsellors and will be writing in the Library/Learning Commons).

Results are reported using a four-category proficiency scale and will appear on a student's transcript as a number, representing one of the four categories:

- emerging (1)
- developing (2)
- proficient (3)
- extending (4)

Students will be able to see their results on their MyEdBC Portal > Assessments. Graduation Assessment results are also posted on student transcripts. Results from this sitting will be posted in MyEdBC on January 6, 2025.
