

## Graduation Ceremony Tickets Requests

Cost per ticket is \$7.50

1<sup>st</sup> Round of Ticket Sales Open on March 30, 2026 (Max 6 tickets)

2<sup>nd</sup> Round of Ticket Sales Open on April 24, 2026 (first come first serve)

Due to the venue capacity there will only be a maximum of 6 tickets per graduating student. After April 24, 2026, the second round of sales will occur, allowing families to access additional tickets (if available).

A quick note to remind you that grad ticketing will look different this year. We have a new **ticketing system** that allows us to offer a more user friendly experience for everyone. This means all ticket sales for grads will be handled by the UVic Ticket Centre. Schools will no longer have to sell tickets and parents/students will be able to go online to book their own seats.

- ✓ UVic will email out a 'How To Book Tickets' a week prior to tickets going on sale.
- ✓ Only students on the list will be able to access the tickets for this event e.g. parents will not be able to purchase tickets using their personal email addresses. The sales must go through the STUDENT'S EMAIL.
- ✓ Special requests can be accommodated – please call the Ticket Centre to book tickets, if accommodations are required **(250-721-8480)**.

**All students accounts have been created. For your first time logging in you will need to reset your password. We HIGHLY recommend you do this before the on sale date.**

- **If using a mobile device we recommend turning in landscape to see the full menu.**

**Tickets will be sent to the grad one week prior to the ceremony, from the UVic ticket Centre, via the student's **sd62 learns.org** email address.**

Tickets can be printed in advance and brought to the venue on the day of the ceremony, or the ticket can be presented on a mobile device where the QR can be easily scanned (Google or Apple Wallets).

Once the tickets are distributed via email, students can contact the UVic Ticket Centre if changes are needed to the seating arrangements. UVic is happy to make changes if seats are available. Making changes to tickets will invalidate the barcode on the exchanged tickets.

The QR of each ticket is linked to the seat and printing multiple tickets of the same seat will not get you in the door. All tickets have the name of the graduation student printed on them.
